

Tito Canella è nato nel 1969 a Milano, dove si è laureato in architettura al Politecnico con Enrico Mantero (borsa "Erasmus" alla Faculty of Engineering and Environment della Southbank University di Londra). Nel 1995 ha fatto uno stage presso lo studio Richard Rogers & Partnership di Londra; nel 1996 ha collaborato alla rivista "Zodiac" con due interviste a Peter Eisenman e Machado & Silvetti; dal 1996 al 1999 ha lavorato a New York presso gli studi Carrano & Wickenburg Architects e Bauhaus Construction Corporation; dal 2000 al 2004 ha fatto parte dello studio Canella Achilli Architetti; dal 2005 svolge la propria attività professionale di progettazione architettonica e d'interni. Le sue realizzazioni sono state pubblicate su volumi e riviste di architettura e interior design.

Tito Canella was born in Milan in 1969. He graduated from the Polytechnic University of Milan in Architecture with Enrico Mantero as his reader. While at university, he won an Erasmus Scholarship to study at the Faculty of Engineering and Environment at Southbank University in London. In 1995 he did an internship with Richard Rogers & Partnership in London. In 1996 he collaborated with the magazine "Zodiac", doing interviews with Peter Eisenman and Machado & Silvetti. He worked from 1996 to 1999 in New York for the architecture firm Carrano & Wickenburg, as well as the Bauhaus Construction Corporation. From 2000 to 2004, he worked with Canella Achilli Architects, and in 2005 he started his own company, working on both architecture projects and interior design. His works have been published in books and magazines on architecture as well as design.
